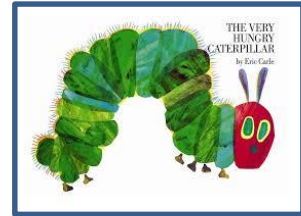
Communication and Language

Understanding
