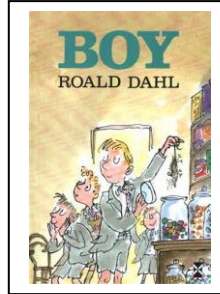
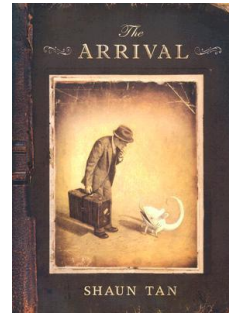


Maths
