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Our Curriculum

Autumn Term

In the autumn our topic will be Stone Age and Darlington. We will learn about the daily lives of these groups and how they have influenced our lives today. Our Science topic is rocks and in RE we will be looking at Sikhism.

Spring Term

In the spring term, we focus on the geography rainforest. We look at where the world's largest rainforest is, the climate, the people who live there and the wildlife. In science we investigate plants, and look at how seed dispersal plays apart in their reproduction. Whilst in mathematics we focus on multiplication and division, money, statistics, length and perimeter and fractions.

Summer Term

In the summer term, we look at the impact of Ancient Egypt. We begin to build up a knowledge of the timeline of Ancient Egypt. We look at the geography of the country and the benefits the Nile River. Also, we look at the gods, the people and culture which they had, whilst comparing it to ours. In science we investigate forces and magnets. Whilst, in maths we look at fractions, time, shape and capacity.

Reading

Our children are encouraged to read at home at least three times a week for ten minutes to develop their reading skills and to share their books with an adult at home. We use reading records in Year 3 to communicate home with how the children are progressing with their reading.

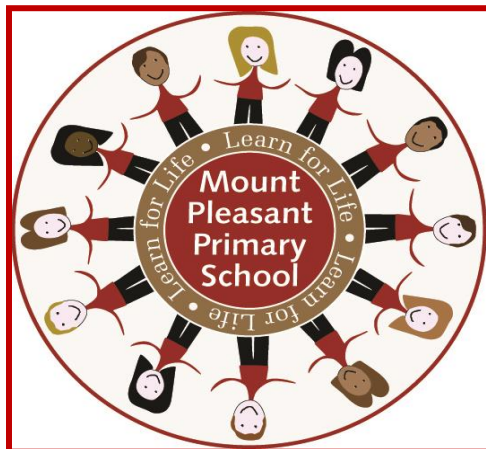
