

Important information—

Please ensure that all of your child's belongings are clearly named.

On PE days, your child will come to school dressed in their PE kit. The day will be confirmed in September.

Please make sure that your child brings their book bag to school everyday. Further information will be given about hearing your child read when they are given their first books. We expect that they read at least 3 times a week at home.

We go outside every day and in all weather. We play in water, mud and sand. It is helpful if your child has their own pair of wellingtons and a waterproof coat that is left in school all the time. Please make sure this is named.

The children will have a snack of fruit and milk every day. This is part of our curriculum and we encourage all children to try new things.

The children have their own water bottle provided by the school. This is kept in school and cleaned and filled up daily.

It is very important that your child attends school as much as possible. Regular attendance is vital as we learn new things everyday.

I hope that you found the information in this booklet useful. Further information will follow in September. There will be a welcome meeting in school where I will give extra details and can answer any questions. 
