



Maths

- Recognise and show, using diagrams, equivalent fractions with small denominators.
- Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator within one whole (for example, $\frac{1}{8} + \frac{3}{8} = \frac{4}{8}$).
- Compare and order unit fractions, and fractions with the same denominators.
- Tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including using Roman numerals and 12-hour to 24-hour clocks.

Geography

Location of River Nile

- Human geography, including: types of settlement and land use, economic activity including trade links, and the distribution of natural resources including energy, food, minerals and water.

Science

Forces and Magnets –

- Compare how things move on different surfaces.
- Notice that some forces need contact between 2 objects, but magnetic forces can act at a distance.
- Observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others.

- To create sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas.
- To improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials [for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay].
