Our Curriculum

Autumn Term

During the autumn term, our topic will be Ancient Greeks. We will learn about daily life in Ancient Greece and how Ancient Greece influenced our lives today. We will hopefully visit the Palace Green Library in Durham to investigate artefacts and take part in workshops about life in Ancient Greece.

Spring Term

During the spring term, our focus will be finding out all about life in Spain. This term is a geography focus. We will find out about the location of Spain, what the physical geography of Spain is like and its climate. We will compare and contrast Spain and the United Kingdom. We will find out about Spanish culture and what it is like to go to school in Spain. In Art, we will produce some art work inspired by Picasso.

Summer Term

During the summer term, our topic will be the Romans. We will be finding out about the way of life in Roman times and why and how the Romans invaded Britain. 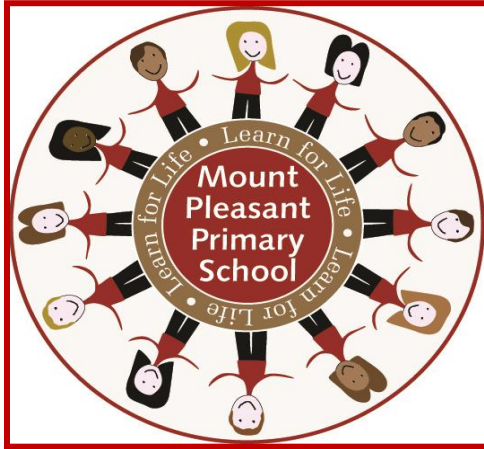

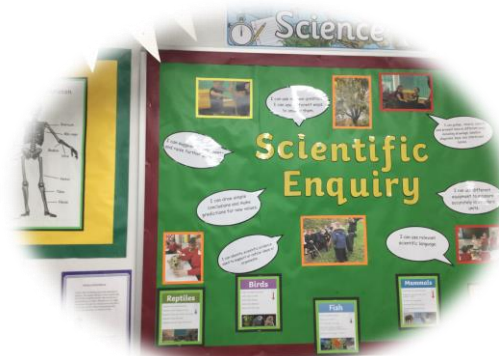
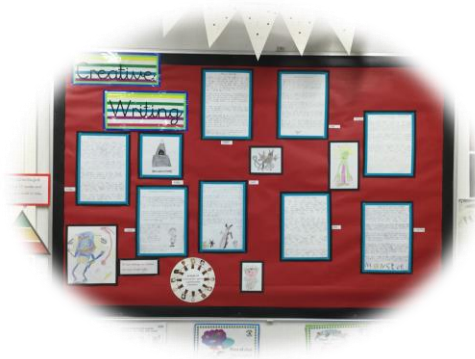
Mount Pleasant Primary School provides a learning environment that opens up the world and takes the pupils on a journey to discover and challenge their thinking.
