




Maths
 This term the children will continue to learn about and use their multiplication knowledge linked to 2s, 5s and 10s times table. The children will begin to learn about simple division. They will name 3D shapes and find out what their properties are. The children will also look at money and solve a range of different money problems. They will also begin to tell and set the time to o'clock and half past. Lastly the children will investigate half and quarter fractions.

Article 13
 Right to find out things and share what you think with others.

MFL
 The children will continue to count and say the alphabet in French. They will also learn a range of French songs.

English
 Over the term the children will look at a range of texts: Percy the Park Keeper, a range of Beatrix Potter stories, invitations, explanations and instructions. They will continue to extend their sentences by using conjunctions like and/because and use descriptive language. They will try to incorporate exclamations and questions into their writing correctly. We are going to have a real focus on spelling this term and thinking about what graphemes should be included in words and how to spell common exception words. Finally the children will begin to look at how to add suffixes (-ed, -ing, -er, -est) to words.



Article 31
 Right to play and rest.

Geography
 The children will be creating their own aerial maps of objects on a table, of the classroom and of the school playground. They will use simple symbols to represent objects. Also they will identify what human and physical features are in their local environment.



History:
 During the term the children will be focusing on the Victorian Times. The children will look at what parks were like and what leisure activities the Victorians did. The children will learn how to use a different range of resources to find out the past and will learn how to use a range of vocabulary to describe the past and present.

R.E
 The children will look at what gods Hindus believe in and how Hindus show that they belong.

Year 1 Summer Term
Topic/theme:

Music
 The children will learn a song called "Your Imagination". They will discuss what they like or dislike about the song. Then they will practise keeping the pulse and copying simple rhythms.

Computing
 The children will be learning how to use simple search engines safely. They will learn that not all information from the internet is true and we need to research carefully. The children will also learn how to save pictures from the internet.

Science
 This term the children will learn about plants. They will learn to name the main parts of a flower and say what their basic job is. They will also be able to name and identify a range of wild and garden plants. The children will also learn the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees.

DT
 This term the children will investigate and make simple mechanisms. They will use these simple mechanisms to design and create a moving picture.

PE
 Children will complete athletic activities where they will practice their footwork, running and arm skills. The children will also learn to skip and practise a range of skills linked to skipping.

Art
 This term we will be looking at the artist Andy Warhol. We will be looking at his art work and using his style and ideas to create our own. Our focus is drawing and we will be exploring colour, pattern and shape.

 We will be looking at what relationships we have with our family and the people who care for us. The children will look at the changes they will come across in their life and the changes that will be occurring this term as they think about transitioning into Year 2.
