Our Curriculum

Autumn Term

During the autumn term, our topic will be 'Britain at War.' We will learn all about the reasons that World War One and Two broke out, which countries were involved and what life was like for the soldiers on the Front Line, women at home, evacuees, The Blitz and how the wars came to an end. We will also study key country leaders involved and how other cultures and religions were affected during this time.

Spring Term

During the spring term, our topic will be 'Brazil.' This term is a geography focus where we will learn to read maps to find specific locations in Brazil, topographical maps, climate and environment and the human geography of Brazil such as settlement, population, housing, education and Fair Trade. We will also learn about Brazilian carnivals and about the street graffiti artist Eduardo Kobra.

Summer Term

During the summer term, our topic will be 'Across the Atlantic.' We will learn all about the slave trade, how it began and worked, the slave trade triangle route from Europe to Africa and then to America, the Underground Railroad, abolishment of slavery, prejudice and racism over the years and we will also look at the life of Rosa Parks.

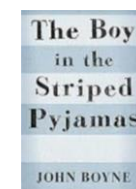


Across the Atlantic

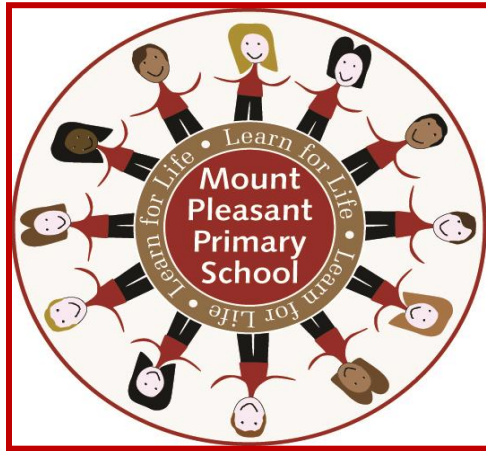
Class Novels
