EYFS	<p>ELGS that feed into Music: Expressive Arts and Design <i>Creating with Materials.</i> The children can safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function. They share their creations, explaining the process/es they have used. The children make use of props and materials when role playing characters in narratives and stories. <i>Being Imaginative and Expressive.</i> The children invent, adapt and recount narratives and stories with peers and their teacher. They sing a range of well-known nursery rhymes and songs. The children perform songs, rhymes and stories with others and, when appropriate, try to move in time with music.</p>
