

Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised

In Year 2 we teaching reading through Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised. This is a phonics programme that teaches the children how to read by decoding and blending all the different graphemes they will come across in texts. It also teaches them how to read tricky words. These are words that can not always be decoded or do not follow the rules the children have been taught yet. The program also helps develop the skills linked to prosody (using an expressive reading voice) and comprehension. It also looks at how to use their reading skills to support extending their range of vocabulary and spelling. Little Wandle is used in conjunction with Big Cat our reading scheme.
